



### **Present voting system**

Election (5p):

- Five votes for each ENCR member, irrespective of size or geographical area
- Countries with national registries (e.g. England, Belgium or the Netherlands) have (much) less votes than countries with many regional registries (e.g. France, Italy, Spain)
- Nomination (4p): IACR, IARC, GRELL and the Nordic countries

Option: up to 2 co-opted members

# **Some principles**

- More democratic (the majority should be elected)
- Representation from all geographical areas (north, east, west, south)
- Simple





## **Proposed voting system**

- Each registry has five votes
- Four representatives will be elected from the four candidates with the highest number of votes per UN geographical area (Northern, Western, Southern & Central/Eastern Europe)
- Another four candidates will be elected based on the highest number of votes (not taking into account the four that were already elected on the basis of the geographical areas)
- One representative from (both) IACR and IARC
- Possibility of one opted representative
- No representatives of Nordic countries or GRELL


