





- To address also data protection issues









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
#### ECIS - European Cancer Information System

Childhood incidence historical data








## Important future milestones for ECIS in the EBCP context

- Enrich ECIS with clinical information stage and treatment variables
- Expansion to the geographical dimension (cancer indicators by **NUTS 2**)
- Facilitating data linkage to demographic, environmental and other datasets to support more targeted cancer prevention
- Improve harmonization and comparability, increasing completeness, timeliness, coverage
