

- 1. Body System (Digestive System)
- Malignancy (Adenocarcinoma M8140)
- 3. Body Part (Right Hemicolon Topography)
- 4. Surgical Action (Resection)
- 5. Approach (Laparoscopic)
- 6. Device (Stapler)



Action Definitions

- JK Excision, total: removing a complete body part
- JI Excision, local: excision of tissue limited to the lesion in question

- Curettage →
 JJ Excision, partial
- Polypectomy →
 JI Excision, local
- Lumpectomy →JJ Excision, partial
- Ablation →
 GA Destruction



International Classification of Health Interventions (WHO)

- For countries that do not have a procedure classification system:
 - Direct use of ICHI
 - Develop a national system based on ICHI
- For countries that already have a procedure classification system:
 - Extend the system: incorporate ICHI's broader range of interventions
 - Map to ICHI → enable comparison with other countries







Systematized Nomenclature of MEDicine – Clinical Terms (SNoMED-CT)












Mapping - Interoperability





Snomed-CT to ICD-9-CM map → algorithm

Step 1

Procedure Name

Name a procedure:

excision remaining thyroid tissue

Step 2

SNOMED CT

Choose the applicable SNOMED CT procedure, or "None of These".

Step 3

ICD-9-CM

Affirm or decline the ICD-9-CM coding.

- ☑ Use the following ICD-9-CM based on the SNOMED CT code:
 - Complete thyroidectomy (06.4)
