#### New ECIS estimates of cancer burden in the EU

New national cancer incidence and mortality estimates for the year 2024 in EU27 countries have been released in ECIS. ECIS estimates are the result of a collaborative project involving the European Commission's Joint Research Centre (JRC), the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC), the European Network of Cancer Registries (ENCR), and the International Association of Cancer Registries (IACR).

#### ECIS Data Call: Submit your data by 31 January 2026

The ENCR and the Joint Research Centre (JRC) of the European Commission are calling on cancer registries across Europe to contribute their data for the fight against cancer. By submitting up-to-date information, registries play a crucial role in strengthening cancer policy, improving patient outcomes, and building a more complete picture of the cancer burden on the continent. The deadline for data submission to be included in the next annual update of the European Cancer Information System (ECIS) is January 31, 2026.

The Country Health Profiles are a comprehensive resource covering each country's latest health policy challenges, health system reforms and investments.
