

ELECTIONS ENCR Steering Committee - Deadline extended for Candidatures

The ENCR is soliciting candidatures for the election to its Steering Committee. It's an opportunity for experts in cancer registration to help shape the priorities of the network in valuing and supporting the European cancer registries work. There are eight vacancies **but not yet enough candidates**. Interested individuals who would like to represent their cancer registry (or group of registries) and are available to contribute to the development of the Network are invited to send their candidature. The deadline is extended until October 31st, 2023.

Publication of cancer incidence and mortality estimates for 2022

The European Cancer Information System (ECIS) has been updated with the national estimates of cancer incidence and mortality for the year 2022. Estimates are available for the major cancer types, in the EU-27 Member States, as well as in other European countries. These estimates are the outcome of a collaboration between the EC Joint Research Centre (JRC) and the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC), with support from the ENCR and the International Association of Cancer Registries (IACR).

Treatment data recoding draft recommendation - consultation to registries

The ENCR working group on treatment data harmonization has completed the first part of its work and proposes a new set of recommendations that are now in the consultation phase to the registries. Registries are invited to analyse it and provide feedback if necessary. Deadline has been extended until November 20th, 2023.
